GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION

Regulations under the Imports and Exports Control Act, No. 1 of 1969

IN terms of the powers vested in me by Section 20 read together with Sub-Section 4(1) and Section 14 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, No. 1 of 1969 as amended by Act, No. 48 of 1985 and Act, No. 28 of 1987, I, Ranil Wickremesinghe, the Minister of Finance, Economic Stabilization and National Policies, promulgate following Regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the "Imports Control Regulations on Payment Terms No. 10 of 2022".
- The Imports Control Regulations on Payment Terms No. 07 of 2022, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2278/21 dated May 06, 2022 as amended by the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2282/21 dated May 31, 2022 is hereby further amended.
- 3. The Regulation No. 4 of the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2278/21 dated May 06, 2022 shall be substituted and read as follows.

4. Regulation No. 3 (I) (b) of the Special Import License and Payment Regulations, No. 1 of 2011, published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 1739/3 dated January 02, 2012, shall be amended that the Open Account Payment Terms or Consignment Account Terms shall only be allowed to;

- (a) Exporters, who are settling their payments for importation of goods, which are necessary for their export purposes from,
 - (i) The export proceeds in their Business Foreign Currency Accounts (BFCAs) or Accounts maintained in the Off-Shore Banking Unit (OBU); or
 - (ii) Foreign currency borrowings from person resident outside Sri Lanka (i.e., Overseas lenders) held in their External Commercial Borrowing Accounts; or
 - (iii) Proceeds of loans obtained for working capital requirement (i.e., short term borrowings) from Overseas lenders as permitted by the Regulations issued under the Foreign Exchange Act, No. 12 of 2017 (FEA);
 - (iv) Proceeds of foreign currency received from non-resident investors into the share capital held in their Special Foreign Currency Account (SFCA), Investee opened and maintained in terms of the Directions issued under the FEA.
 - (b) Local suppliers (Indirect Exporters), who import and supply goods for those exporters, receiving payments in the foreign currency and making payment for importation of goods for such supply using;
 - (i) The foreign currency so received to their Business Foreign Currency Accounts (BFCAs) or Accounts maintained in the Off-Shore Banking Unit (OBU);

or

or

(ii) Proceeds of foreign currency received in terms of provisions in the Paragraph (a) (ii), (iii) and (iv) referred above.

- (c) Local manufacturers, who import goods as raw materials which are not available locally but required for manufacturing of their products with minimum local value addition of 30% or more, subject to a letter of authorization issued by Controller General of Imports and Exports based on the recommendation of the Secretary, Ministry of Industries, prior to arrival of such goods to any Ports / Airports of Sri Lanka.
- (d)Importers, who import essential food commodities (goods), prescribed in the Schedule I of these Regulations, subject to recommendation of the Secretary, Ministry of Trade, Commerce and Food Security, obtained prior to arrival of such goods to the Ports / Airports of Sri Lanka, during the period of July 01, 2022 to August 31, 2022.

The Director General, Sri Lanka Customs shall provide details of importation of goods (Names of importers / consignees, Description and HS Codes of Goods, imported quantities and CIF value) under this Regulation to the Secretary, Ministry of Trade, Commerce and Food Security on Monday of every week.

- 4. Exporters, who are falling within the provisions of regulation No. 4(a) of the Imports Control Regulations on Payment Terms No. 07 of 2022, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2278/21 dated May 06, 2022 as amended above, shall be exempted from the regulations Nos. 5 and 6 of the said regulations on the basis of details of exporters, provided by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka to the Director General, Sri Lanka Customs.
- **5.** Indirect exporters, who are falling within the provisions of regulation No. 4(b) of the Imports Control Regulations on Payment Terms No. 07 of 2022, published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2278/21 dated May 06, 2022 as amended above, shall be exempted from the regulations Nos. 5 and 6 of the said regulations on the basis of submission of endorsement from his bank(s) quarterly basis certifying that particular indirect exporter is operating one or more foreign currency accounts as specified in the regulation No.4(b) of the Imports Control Regulations on Payment Terms No. 07 of 2022 to the Director General, Sri Lanka Customs.

- **6.** The Controller General, Department of Imports and Exports Control shall issue required "Operating Instructions" to the Director General, Sri Lanka Customs and licensed banks for effective implementation of these Regulations.
- 7. The Director General of Customs shall act in accordance with the provisions of the Customs Ordinance on any importation made in violation of the above Regulations. However, The Director General, Sri Lanka Customs shall consult the Controller General, Department of Imports and Exports Control on any importation made in violation of the Regulation No. 4(c) of the Gazette Extraordinary No. 2278/21 dated May 06, 2022 as amended above.
