## Government Subsidies for International Quality Certificates - 2026 ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 22000, ISO 50001

The Ministry of Industry and Entrepreneurship Development has planned to implement this program under special sponsorship to enhance the productivity of local industries by improving quality management, enhancing environmental management, increasing energy efficiency and food security, and to enable local industries to face competition in the export market. For this purpose, the following small industry sectors or medium-scale industry sectors with an annual turnover of less than Rs. 675 million and less than 125 employees as of January 01, 2026 can apply to obtain the above international quality certificates.

### Benefits:

- For selected industries, certification fees up to a maximum of Rs. 200,000/- and relevant fees will be reimbursed upon submission of certificates and bills.
- If consultancy services are obtained from a recognized government-affiliated institution or a consultancy firm updated on the Ministry's website, consultancy service fees will be reimbursed up to a maximum of Rs. 100,000/-.

### Eligibility:

Should have been operating as a manufacturing industry for at least last 3 years (production reports must be submitted).

The industry should have been in a good operating condition at the time of application.

- It is mandatory to be an industry that has not applied for certification and consultancy institutions to obtain relevant certificates at the time of the interview.
- Upon the selection, priority will be given to industries that have not received any benefits in previous years under the above certification program.

### Selection Procedure:

- Selection will be made based on the conditions stated in the newspaper advertisement and the facts verified at the interview.

### Other Conditions:

- Certificates should be obtained from a certification body accredited under the Sri Lanka Accreditation Board (SLAB).
- Selected applicants should enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Ministry ensuring completion of certification process of their institution before the due date.
- The quality certificate obtained should be continuously kept updated for at least 05 years.
- The certificate & relevant bills should be submitted to the Ministry on or before 30th October 2026 to reimburse the certification fee.
- Should be a local industry and the local partner should own at least 60% of the company ownership.
- The relevant industry should not have received similar benefits from any other government institution during the certification process.
- Only one company from a group of companies can apply for this program.
